

Engineering consulting firm Aarvee Associates has won the contract to prepare the detailed project report (DPR) for the Madurai Mass Rapid Transit System (MRTS) in Tamil Nadu. The project is expected to ease traffic congestion and provide better connectivity in the region. According to sources, Aarvee Associates was selected by the Madurai Metro Rail Corporation Limited (MMRCL) through a competitive bidding process. The firm will be responsible for preparing the DPR, which will include the technical specifications, cost estimates, and other details of the project.
