Manoj Kumar Upadhya, the company's creator, stated at the Tamil Nadu Investors' First Port of Call-Investment Conclave on Monday that this will be one of the biggest such factories in the world.

The greatest investment disclosed during the occasion was this one.

The fertiliser business will receive chemicals from the green ammonia hydrogen, while the electricity and shipping industries will receive fuel.
