



Bharti Airtel has announced that its subsidiary **Nxtra** will invest **Rs 5,000 crore** by 2025 to scale up its **data centre business**.

Nxtra plans to build **seven hyperscale data centres** that will treble its capacities, attract business from neighbouring countries, and **help India become a regional hub for data centres**.

According to **Ajay Chitkara, director and chief executive officer**, Airtel Business, the investment will be made through a mix of internal accruals, equity infusion, and debt. Private equity firm Carlyle holds a 25 per cent stake in Nxtra Data.

According to Chitkara, the company has around 400 Indian and global customers, and its revenue has trebled since 2017-18.
