



A preliminary agreement was signed by Bharat Heavy Electricals and Nuclear Power Corporation to seek business potential in nuclear power based on pressurised heavy water reactor technology.

To shorten project gestation times, BHEL and NPCIL will collaboratively investigate potential for the development of nuclear power projects within the terms of the agreement.

“State-run PSUs Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd (NPCIL) and Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd (BHEL) have entered into an MoU (memorandum of understanding) to jointly pursue business opportunities in the area of Nuclear Power Plants based on Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor (PHWR) technology,” the statement read.
