

Tender has been floated by Bihar State Road Development Corporation for construction of four-lane elevated road.

The project has to be completed in a period of 23 months at a cost of Rs 535.28 crore. The scope of work envisages construction of four-lane elevated road as a part of JP Ganga Path (Digha to Deedarganj from Nurruding Ghat (ch 16,975.79 km) to Dharamshala Ghat (ch 19.890 km) (length – 2.914 km) with allied facilities and widening and strengthening of existing road to four-lane from the Junction of JP Ganga Path at Deedarganj (ch 20.500 km) to ROB approach on SH-106 (old NH-30) (length – 750 mtr) and development of four-lane road from Patna Sahib railway station (ch 0.000) to Patna Ghat (ch 1.550) in replacement of existing old railway line of Patna Sahib-Patna Ghat on EPC mode.
