



The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) authorised the doubling of the Nimach-Ratlam railway line on Wednesday.

Anurag Thakur, Minister of Information and Broadcasting, Sports and Youth Affairs, informed reporters following a Cabinet meeting that the overall projected cost of the project is 1,095.88 crore, and the escalated / completion cost is **1,184.67 crore.**

The capacity of the Nimach-Ratlam segment will be increased by doubling it. As a result, additional freight and passenger trains may be added to the system. Because of the closeness of cement factories, extra freight traffic of **5.67 million tonnes** per year is projected in the first year, increasing to **9.45 mtpa** in the eleventh year.
