



To boost domestic production and export of green hydrogen or ammonia, the government plans to give incentives similar to those offered under production-linked incentive (PLI) programmes. Some of the initiatives, such as export incentives, may be included in the planned National Green Hydrogen Mission (NGHM).

According to a senior government official, the incentives might be granted for a five-year period to support a minimum of 10 MMTPA (million metric tonnes per year) of green hydrogen or green ammonia exports by 2030 and a 50 MMTPA green hydrogen or ammonia market by 2030 in the nation.

“The government could assist a PLI scheme for electrolyser manufacturing and on its components like electrodes and membranes, manufacturing of H<sub>2</sub> storage, NH<sub>3</sub> storage, NH<sub>3</sub> loop,” the official added.

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
