



Clothing retailer H&M has partnered with Industrial [Solar GmbH](#), a division of [Clean Industry Solutions Holding](#) (CISH) with headquarters in Germany, to develop a solar project for [Arvind Ltd.](#), one of its largest textile suppliers in India.

By utilising clean, renewable energy and lowering emissions, the firm hopes to lower its carbon impact in the apparel sector.

According to a news statement from [CISH](#), H&M and Industrial Solar have agreed to conduct an engineering study as the first step towards integrating a concentrating solar collector into [Arvind Ltd.](#)'s textile production.

The deal requires Industrial Solar to construct a demonstration project for [Arvind Ltd.](#) that will provide the proof of concept for the incorporation of a concentrating solar thermal system to produce direct steam for textile processes.

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
