



Indian Hotels Company (IHCL) has signed a Vivanta hotel in Nashik. The hotel, which is part of a mixed-use complex near Dwarka Circle, is managed by Deepak Builders & Developers. Nashik has always been an integral part of India’s religious tourism circuit and has evolved to become an important industrial centre. The Vivanta hotel, which will have 144 rooms, will be conveniently placed adjacent to the Nashik Freeway, near to the city’s IT zone, and the forthcoming metro station at Dwarka Circle.
