



Jakson Green has agreed to invest Rs 22,400 crore to build a green hydrogen and green ammonia project in Rajasthan over the course of several years.

According to a statement from **Jakson Green**, the business and the Rajasthan government have an MOU to this effect.

According to the statement, **Jakson Green** would construct a 3,65,000 tonne per year green hydrogen and ammonia plant together with a phased-in integrated hybrid renewable power complex.
