

A Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) for the supply of green energy has been signed by Michelin, a leading mobility and technology firm, and CleanMax Enviro Energy Solutions Pvt. Ltd.

With the first long-term open access PPA, Michelin's facility in Thervoykandigai will now use 37% more renewable energy than it does now, down from 11%, and 11,712 tonnes less CO2 will be emitted yearly.

Speaking on the collaboration, Florent Chaussade, Plant Director, Michelin Chennai stated, "Michelin Group's societal responsibility is embodied by its Sustainable Development and Mobility strategy. Our aim is to make Michelin one of the most innovative, responsible, and high-performing companies worldwide across all of its responsibilities: economic, environmental, social and societal.
