

Lindstrom India, a subsidiary of the Finnish textile service company Lindstrom Oy, has increased activities in this location's workwear service unit in an effort to meet the country's expanding demand in the south.

According to JuhaLaurio, president and chief executive officer of Lindstrom Group, the Chennai unit is anticipated to employ roughly 100 individuals with the extension of activities. The expanded workwear service plant at Singaperumalkoil, some 45 kilometres away, would cater to the rising demand in south India's automotive, electronics, food, pharmaceutical, and healthcare sectors.
