

Chennai Metro Rail Limited has awarded a contract worth Rs 360 crore to Linxon India Private Limited for 25 kV OHE and power supply systems for Phase 2 corridors of Chemmai Metro Rail Project.

Sources said that the tender for design, manufacturing, supply, installation, testing, training, and commissioning of RSS, ASS, SCADA, OHE and switching Station for Chennai Metro's Phase II Corridor 3 and Corridor 5 was issued in October 2021 with 1150 day work completion deadline.
