

The state urban development department of Mumbai has approved the transfer of 7.7 hectares (19 acres) of special development zone land in Powai to an industrial zone. Yotta of the Hiranandani group will be allowed to put up a data centre in Powai as a result of this.

The no development zone was called a special development zone in the Development Plan 2034.
