



MicroBite has developed a technique that will minimise fermentation time. The ethanol and beverage sectors are affected by this. Fermentation periods are shorter, which means production times are shorter.

The business has put up plans to build a bioethanol factory in the state with a capacity of five kilolitres per day (KLPD). Nalgonda, Zaheerabad, and Siddipet are being considered as viable locations. Due to the availability of molasses, these have been narrowed down.
