The project involves upgrading a berth number-2 at Haldia Dock Complex at Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port (SMP), Kolkata, the only riverine port in the country. The project will have a capacity to handle over 3.74 million tonnes annually. The estimated cost of the project is Rs.2980 million. On February 2022, company has received a letter of award.
