40,000 crore, the Gujarat government and Ocior Energy India Pvt Ltd inked a memorandum of understanding (MoU) for the generation of green hydrogen and green ammonia. According to the agreement, which was inked in front of Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, Ocior Energy will spend Rs 40,000 crore to build a facility in Gujarat's Kutch district that will create 1 million tonnes of green hydrogen and ammonia annually.
