

Rajasthan govt approves Rs 37.75 crore for expansion work of 10  
airstrips | 1



The state of Rajasthan's government has approved spending of Rs 37.75 crore for expansion projects at 10 airstrips.

According to a formal announcement, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot has approved the budget for a number of airfield development projects, including the construction of boundary walls, campus walls, and airstrip renovation.

The relocation of the super highway, Buddha Mandavar Road, and building of a boundary wall for the Kolana airfield would each receive Rs. 14 crore, while the Abu Road airstrip will receive Rs. 4 crore for similar work.
