



For its expansion project in Hazira, Gujarat, AMNS India received 1,800 tonnes of structural steel from [RINL](#), a firm located in Visakhapatnam.

On October 28, the Gujarat-based steel manufacturer AMNS India began construction on a Rs 60,000 crore expansion project to increase the steel plant's capacity from the current 9 million tonnes (MT) to 15 MT.
