



After [Chennai Metro Rail Ltd.](#) (CMRL) released technical bids on Monday, 6 companies submitted offers for 2 different contracts to commission the electrification system for lines 3 and 5 of the Chennai Metro (OHE, RSS, ASS, & SCADA).

Both of these lines, which are now under construction as part of [Chennai Metro](#)'s 118.9 km Phase 2 project, would connect Madhavaram – SIPCOT (Line-3, 45.813 km) and Madhavaram – Sholinganallur (Line-5, 47 km) with a combination of elevated and underground stations. The 25 km Madhavaram Milk Colony – Sholinganallur stretch of Line-3 and the 23 km Madhavaram Milk Colony – CMBT section of Line-5, as well as its shared Madhavaram Depot, are covered under these two electrification system contracts.

[CMRL](#) had invited tenders for both contracts in October 2021 with an unknown estimate and 2350 day (6.44 year) completion deadlines.

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
