

Suzlon Group has announced that it would establish a 180.6 megawatt (MW) wind power project for Sembcorp's Indian affiliate in Kanakagiribad and Bagalkot (Karnataka). The facility is anticipated to be operational in 2024.

The homegrown wind turbine manufacturer secured the order from the Singapore-based utilities company's renewable energy (RE) subsidiary, Green Infra Wind Energy. Under the contract, the company will install 86 wind turbine generators (WTGs) with a Hybrid Lattice Tubular (HLT) tower and a rated capacity of 2.1 MW each, Suzlon said in a statement. Suzlon will supply the wind turbines (equipment supply) and execute the project including, erection and commissioning. Suzlon will also provide comprehensive operation, and maintenance services post commissioning, the company added.
