



SWELECT Energy Systems Ltd, formerly Numeric Power Systems, a manufacturer of solar photovoltaic modules, announced the opening of its solar module manufacturing unit in Tamil Nadu.

SWELECT's 140 MW facility in Bengaluru has been superseded by the launch of the new facility in Sarkarsamakulam, located on the outskirts of the city.

The manufacturing unit's output would be increased from 385 MW to 595 MW, according to managing director R Chellappan.

He told reporters that his company, which has a 5% market share, has installed about 3,800 solar roof tops and 6,000 water pumps.
