

The Syama Prasad Mookerjee (SPM) port - previously Kolkata port — will undergo a significant facelift in the next two years, with a plethora of projects planned, including increasing port capacity, modernising infrastructure, and monetising assets. The Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port Authority (SPMPA) will have to pay around 1,700 crore for these.
