



The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) said that the telecom equipment manufacturer HFCL Limited has received an order for Rs 80.92 crore.

For the Delhi Metro Rail Project, HFCL will build up a Fibre Optics Transmission System (FOTS), according to a release.
