

The Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (Yeida) said that it has paid the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) 1.87 crore rupees for the creation of a detailed project report (DPR) to link Knowledge Park II in Greater Noida to the New Delhi railway station. For the vital link that seeks to offer direct connectivity from Jewar airport to Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport, the Yeida already has a feasibility report from the DMRC. In the upcoming six months, the DMRC will develop and submit the DPR to Yeida, according to officials.

The DMRC will go to work on the DPR right away because the project needs to be finished in six months. A Metro route must be constructed to connect the future Noida International Airport with the

We need to build a Metro corridor that will connect the upcoming Noida International Airport with the Indira Gandhi International Airport directly," said ArunVir Singh, Yeida chief executive officer (CEO).
