



The Hiranandani Group's **Yotta Infrastructure** would invest **Rs 900 crore** over three to four years to **build 100 Edge datacenters**.

The firm would begin with eight to ten cities, with each facility costing around **Rs 8 to 10 crore** for basic infrastructure. The business is looking at 25 minor cities in Phase-I, including **Nagpur, Coimbatore, Ranchi** and **Jaipur**.

The company operates **Tier IV** data centre parks in **Mumbai, Navi Mumbai, and Chennai**. Two versions have been developed by the business. In the first scenario, an edge datacenter will be established in an existing building. According to rumours, the second model will be a container-based greenfield project.
